Dear Forcheck user,

This is the first Forcheck newsletter. We will publish one when we have relevant information to share.

We proudly introduce Forcheck version 14. Forcheck version 13 has been on the market for 7 years. Many subversions and releases have been released to expand Forcheck's possibilities, make improvements and correct errors. Your input was of great assistance to us.

Forcheck version 14 supports full Fortran 2003. While the Fortran compilers on the market gradually support the new Fortran 2003 features Forcheck is ready to support the complete language. Using the compiler emulation files we can keep up with new releases of the compilers. Moreover, you can already test your code for standard conformance.

Beside full Fortran 2003 support, Forcheck version 14 has many improvements as compared to version 13. Analysis and reporting has again been improved. Among other features the data types parameters are now being presented in the cross-reference tables.
